# COVID-19 vaccination

## First phase priority groups



Priority	Risk group
1	Residents in a <b>care home</b> for older adults and Staff working in <b>care homes</b> for older adults
2	All those <b>80 years</b> of age and over and <b>Health and social care workers</b>
3	All those <b>75 years</b> of age and over
4	All those <b>70 years</b> of age and over and <b>Clinically extremely vulnerable individuals</b> (not including pregnant women and those under 18 years of age)
5	All those <b>65 years</b> of age and over
6	Adults aged <b>18 to 65 years</b> in an at-risk group *
7	All those <b>60 years</b> of age and over
8	All those <b>55 years</b> of age and over
9	All those <b>50 years</b> of age and over
10	<b>Rest of the population</b> (to be determined)

\* Blood cancer (such as leukaemia, lymphoma or myeloma); diabetes; dementia; a heart problem; a chest complaint or breathing difficulties, including bronchitis, emphysema or severe asthma; a kidney disease; a liver disease, lowered immunity due to disease or treatment (such as HIV infection, steroid medication, chemotherapy or radiotherapy); rheumatoid arthritis, lupus or psoriasis; have had an organ transplant; had a stroke or a transient ischaemic attack (TIA); a neurological or muscle wasting condition; a severe or profound learning disability; a problem with your spleen, eg sickle cell disease, or you have had your spleen removed; are seriously overweight (BMI of 40 and above); are severely mentally ill.
